CATEGORIES for Three Blind Mice Show August 2011

Guidelines:

The display may be entered in more than one display as it may fit, such as a fantasy scene with a self-made doll displayed in a roombox. The entry could be in fantasy, dolls, and roombox. You must mark the categories on your registration form to be considered for all 3.

1. Buildings

These may be shops, barns/other farm buildings, business-type buildings, sheds, churches, etc.; these may be a roombox style.

2. Club Project

This category is for club display project worked on by **DMS** members only for 2011.

3. Dolls

Dolls may be constructed of porcelain, Fimo, Sculpey or other compositions. Must be dressed, wigged or painted by individual entering. *Dolls displayed in other categories may be judged in this category*.

4. Dollhouses

These can be any manufactured, scratch-built or kit-bashed building that is a house/home.

5. Fantasy

This includes fairies, cartoon characters, fictional events, wizards and other types of scenes that are not readily found in the real world.

6. Seasonal/Holidays

Rooms, scenes, vignettes, etc. that show any traditionally celebrated holiday. Please name the holiday in the description section on form.

7. Junior

For individuals age 16 and under; work must be done by the entrant with less than 20% help or guidance of adult.

8. Landscaping and Outdoor Scenes

Buildings, vignettes, settings in which landscaping is the predominant feature.

9. Roomboxes & Special Collections

These are scenes, collections, a single room, a collection of miniature items within a certain theme, such as china, single type of furniture (i.e. chairs), dolls, or needlework.

10. Smaller Scales

Any item, scene, roombox or display less than 1/12-scale.; does not include dollhouses in any scale.

11. Unusual Containers

An every-day item (bread box, watering can, teapot, etc.) that has been modified to contain a miniature scene

12. Vignettes

A small part of a scene such as the corner of a room, view from a window, a door, a back or front porch, a garden gate, etc. These are not roomboxes, houses, etc. These are just that are independent of a house or larger structure.

The Exhibits Committee reserves the right to place an entry in another category if it's felt the entry has a better chance of winning a ribbon in another category with fewer entrants.
